### Impulse management prepares us for college

#### We can manage our impulsivity through classroom routines

Enter the classroom	<ol> <li>Bring your binder, calculator, and pencil</li> <li> walk into the classroom and take the notes from Ms. Chang</li> <li>Go straight to your seat</li> <li>Work on the Do Now</li> </ol>
Do now (5 min)	<ol> <li>, andwhen bell rings</li> <li>You can find the Do Now question on the</li> <li>Ms. Chang will go over the answers</li> <li>No work shown =%</li> </ol>
Notes (20 min)	<ol> <li>take notes on the notes handout so that everything on the board is in your notes</li> <li>If you have a question or an answer, silently</li> <li>and for Ms. Chang to call on you</li> </ol>

### Managing our impulsivity

Bathroom	<ol> <li>Silently raise fingers crossed</li> <li>If Ms. Chang says yes, silently take the bathroom pass</li> <li>You have minutes</li> <li>Silently re-enter the room, place the bathroom pass back in the folder, and go straight back to your seat</li> </ol>
Tissue	<ol> <li>Silently raise two fingers up</li> <li>Stay Ms. Chang will pass you the tissues</li> <li>Throw out your tissue trash when</li> </ol>
Pencil	<ol> <li>Silently raise your index finger</li> <li>Stay Ms. Chang will pass you a pencil sharpener and pick it up from you when she can</li> </ol>
Leave the classroom	<ol> <li>Stay seated until</li> <li>Check your desk area for belongings and</li> <li>Push in your</li> <li>Place all trash in the trash on your way out</li> </ol>

DO	DON'T
<ol> <li>Stay in your assigned seat unless you have permission to get up</li> <li>Use classroom hand signals such as:</li></ol>	<ol> <li>Do not get up during class to:</li> <li>Get tissue or sharpen your pencil. Ms. Chang will bring tissues and a sharpener to you</li> <li>Throw away trash. Throw your trash away when you leave the classroom</li> </ol>
2. Take notes, complete the Do Now, classwork, and homework (together they are % of your grade!)	<ul> <li>2. Do not talk when the teacher is talking.</li> <li>During partner practice, you will have minutes to talk quietly with your desk partner</li> </ul>
